


The Interurban

The Northwestern Pacific Interurban rail line went out of service after the construction of the Golden Gate Bridge. Of the old rail lines around the Bay Area, only two survived: Southern Pacific as Caltrain on the Peninsula and as Amtrak service in the East Bay, and the San Francisco Municipal Railway as Muni. But what if the Northwestern Pacific passenger lines had survived? What might it look like today?
